

We wish to inform you that the European Federation of Chemical Engineering has authorized the Czech Society of Chemical Engineering to set up a European Chemical Engineers' Directory (ECED). The Directory is available at the web site www.eced.cz

Entry into the Directory is free of charge for any person who considers himself a chemical or process engineer. Interested persons should submit their personal data, interests and possibly their expertise or special offers. The Directory is operated at 2 levels: data from Level 1 will be available only for use of the European Federation of Chemical Engineering whilst data from Level 2 will appear on the Internet where every person who submitted his data will have his own web page. Persons who enter the Directory will receive passwords so that they can update their data at any time.

The Directory is provided with search pages so that it will be possible to make searches for names of persons or organisations, for persons with interest in a special subject or for persons with expertise or special offers in specific subjects.

The Directory is starting now in April 2004 and so it will take some time to build up the database but it is hoped that within several months it will become a useful tool for gaining information and finding contacts. There are no deadlines for entering the Directory but the sooner anyone enters the sooner he can be contacted by other chemical and process engineers and the sooner he can start receiving information from the European Federation of Chemical Engineering.
